



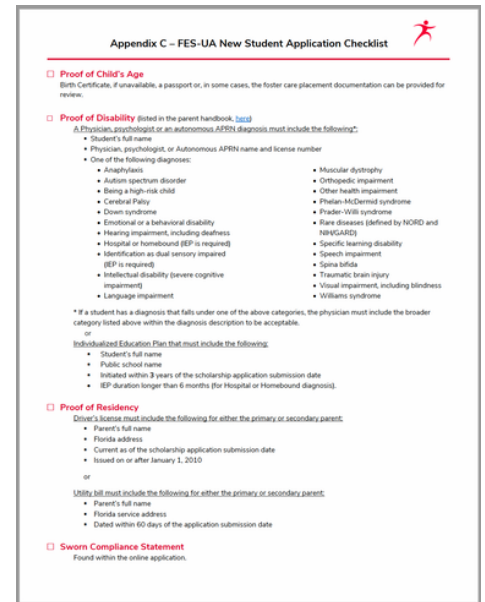
How to Apply for "Step Up for Students" Scholarship

1) You will need a copy of Appendix C - FES UA New Student Application Checklist (pictured) 

2) You will need a "Proof of Disability" for your application

3) Usually, physicians use their script pad or office letter head to include:

- Name of child
- Date of Birth
- Physicians' APRN name and license number
- List any diagnosis from the attached document.
- MD signature and date.



4) Below are the common **ICD 10 codes** we have successfully experienced using with this scholarship.

(We recommend highlighting Dyslexia and Learning Disorder; if you include both, then it ensures that the right code is included. We also recommend adding "At risk for developmental delays." Also, additional codes will help with the level of care assigned, so include all that apply below.)
